As you can see, there are a lot of activities concerning car shows and parades. I have found that a lot of the local area events have not been up-to-date, so don't hang your hat too heavy concerning the dates listed (I believe most will be close, but you might check the event out yourself as to the date, when any applications need to be in and if they are car shows, if there are limits to the vehicles year.)

I have not received much information concerning the recent club activities, but here is some information I have received: (there is some other information in the meeting minutes)

Eagles Car Show – Yakima (this was listed in the newsletter for the 19th, but it was reported to me that it was actually a week earlier; same time as the Zillah parade). This was reported by Dave Haynes. They had a good turn-out of approx. 80 vehicles or all types. I believe this is the second year for this show; and it takes time and fortitude on the part of the organizers as to making a show what they would like it to be. We might try to keep this one in mind for next year. Maybe Dave could remind us for 2019?

Zillah Parade – Zillah; There were approx. 18 club cars in the line-up (depending on who counted and when). It was nice to have staging on grass, but it was still a little warm. We traveled the parade route two abreast to a very warm, responsive and large crowd. After the parade the majority of us continued to Jim and Jason's for a terrific BBQ and social time.

Selah Parade – Selah; The club had approx. 10 vehicles in the line-up. We were close to the end of the parade so there was time to walk part of the parade line to see some of the other participants. Sometimes you don't get this type of opportunity. The parade route was different than in the past. It kept the parade out of the Main street area. I believe it was a better parade because of it. We had one member have his car over-heat (I believe this was the problem). And needed to be pushed onto a side road. We had room on this parade to go single file so most of us was able to take the parade route in a serpentine fashion. I think the crowd enjoyed it more than just going straight down the road. There seems to be less stop and go driving in this manner that is the nemesis to cars in most parades (although it makes more work for the driver and some parades do not allow this type of driving.)

Richland Car Show – Richland, WA (5/27/18): There were 10 club members who attended this show. Seven of these 10 members received a trophy, which is a very good representation in anyone's book. The Pacific Northwest Mustang Club always puts on a good show, how they can pull it off again in the fall at their show in Patterson is beyond me. The Richland Car Show was held at a different location than in the past, less trees, but still shade to be found. There was ample room for visitors to park and enjoy the show.
