## Executive Board Meeting

### March 21, 2023 Ranch House Restaurant, Ahtanum WA.

Executive Board Members Present: Pres. Rob Lions, VP John Mertell, Treasure Jim Herriman, Past Pres. Bruce Docken. Guests: Dave Mitts and Mark Sires

The Executive Board Meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM by Pres. Rob Lions.

TREASURES REPORT: CHECKING: \$4814.33 SAVINGS: \$2017.59.

- The \$1500 check to Children's Wishes and Dreams still needs to be issued.
- There was also a discussion by the Executive Board to change banks. The Executive Board will further discuss that and make a decision.
- The SCMC Constitution and amendments to the Constitution were discussed. Revision proposal D of the last approved Constitution of SCMC from 2013 was drafted, voted on, and approved unanimously by all Executive Board Members present. The amended Constitution will be presented to the membership at the next regular club meeting and will also be e-mailed out to the membership to review in advance of the club meeting.
- The activities for National Mustang Day on Saturday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, was discussed. This will be discussed at the general club meeting. The Executive Board would like all club cars to park in the parking lot along the public road for higher visibility. Bruce Docken will coordinate the event and provide additional details.
- There was a discussion about reviving the annual Founders award. This was an award given to a club member for meritorious service to the club in the prior year. The member getting the award was selected by the founding members. It was felt that because the number of Founding members has significantly decreased, that this might be revived instead by the Executive Board selecting the member to receive the award. This will be discussed with the membership at the next meeting.
- There was a discussion about two new auto parts stores opening in Yakima (a NAPA and an Auto Zone). There was a discussion about having a club cruise in at one or both of their openings. This will be discussed with the businesses to gauge their interest.
- There was a discussion of planning a club "poker run" to various Vic's Auto Parts stores in Yakima and the valley. This will be further discussed for interest and planning.
- The need for members to start seeking sponsorships from businesses for the car show was discussed.

#### **\*\*CLUB MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO START GETTING SPONSIRSHIPS NOW\*\***

- Cost of the Ponies in the Sun T-shirts sold at the SCMC show, and the profit margin, was discussed. T-shirt prices will need to go up to cover costs and have some profit margin on them.
- The Car show (just our Club) at the Sun Country Estates Club House on April 29<sup>th</sup> was discussed. Jan will be asked to present an update at the next club meeting. \$15.00 admission – car show and all the pancakes you can eat.
- The need to clarify our use of Round Table Pizza for our regular club meetings on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month was discussed. We get the space free PROVIDED members spend at least \$200 on food and drink. Our current spend at this meeting exceeds \$200 so the Executive Board does not anticipate any need to change locations.

- It was noted that Round Table Pizza closes business hours at 8 PM, so the business portion of the meeting must start promptly at 7 PM, the meeting must be kept moving and long-winded speeches may need to be cut short, and we need to vacate promptly at 8 PM.
- Pres. Rob Lions will discuss changing the table arrangements with Round Table Pizza to make the room more conducive to a meeting. If Round Table Pizza allows this, when the meeting ends, club members will be asked to put the tables and chairs back in their original positions.

The Executive Board Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.

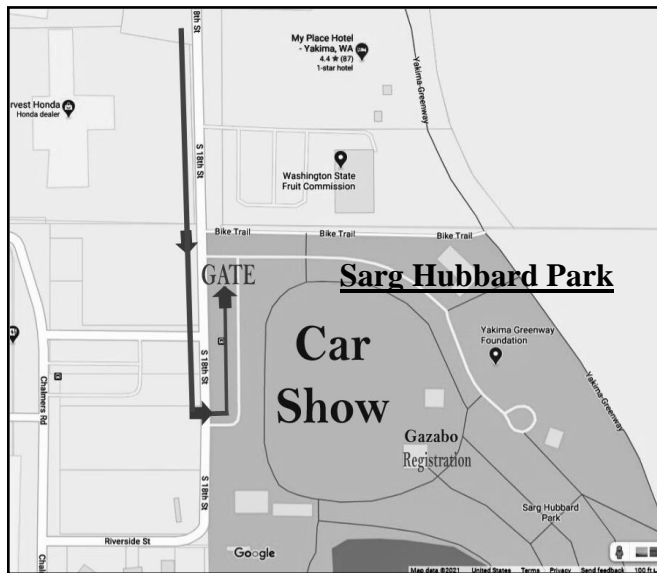
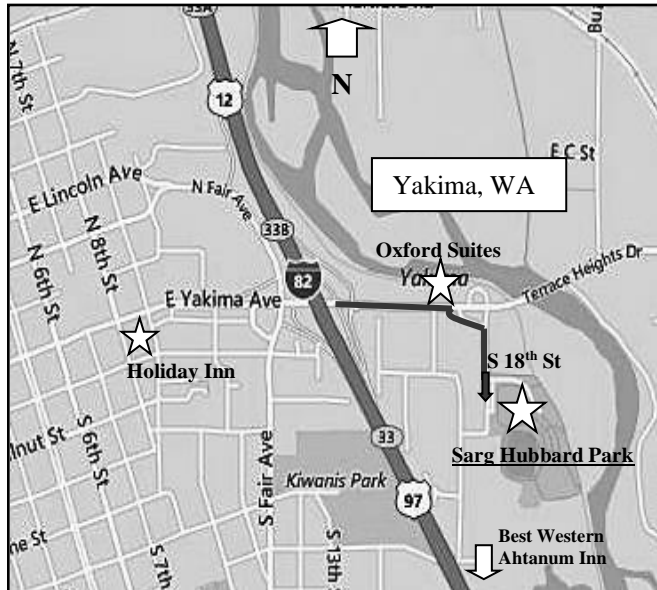
